

Angel Kisses  
Approx size 12" x 30"

- Tea or coffee dye Stitchery if desired, fuse pellon and stitch over all lines, press well and trim back to:
  - Heart: 4 ½" x 5 ½"
  - Main pic: 7 ½" x 6 ½"
  - Quote: 6 ½" x 4 ½"
- Cut first borders
  - Heart
    - 2 @ 6 ½" x 1 ½" dark red
    - 2 @ 5 ½" x 2" dark red
    - 4 @ 2" x 1" floral
  - Main Pic:
    - 2 @ 6 ½" x 1 ½" dark red
    - 2 @ 7 ½" x 1" dark red
    - 4 @ 1 ½" x 1" floral
  - Quote:
    - 2 @ 6 ½" x 1 ½" dark red
    - 2 @ 4 ½" x 1 ½" dark red
    - 4 @ 1" x 1 ½" floral
- Cut second borders -floral
  - Cut 4 @ 2 ½" x 7 ½"
  - Cut 2 @ 2 ½" x 29 ½"
  - Cut 1 @ 7 ½" 2 ½"
- Bows cut:
  - 2 @ 6" x 2 ½" (bows) floral
  - 2 @ 2 ½" x 2 ½" (hangers) floral
  - 2 @ 2" x 3" (centres) – dark red



Construction – all seams are ¼"

- Attach borders to sides of each Stitchery
- Attach a small piece to either end of each remaining border strip. Press and join to top and bottom of each Stitchery matching corner seams.
- Lay out stitcheries as per photograph and join a 7 ½" to the top of each one and the bottom of the quote stitchery.
- Join long strips to each side.
- Join the remaining 7 ½" 2<sup>nd</sup> border strip across the bottom. Make a scallop template to fit and on the wrong side mark around your shape with permanent pen or lead pencil.
- Bows – fold bow piece right sides together to form a long tube, sew leaving an opening in the centre of the long side. Trim corners and turn through. Press. Repeat for other bow.
- Fold the raw edges to the centre of centre pieces wrong sides together so the join is going to be on the inside of the loop. Press.
- Gather up bows slightly and place centre loop around covering the opening. The ends will overlap on the back of the bow. Fold under the raw edge of the loop and stitch to secure. The loop needs to be tight enough to keep the bow gathered.
- Stitch the long edge of each hanger strip. Turn the tube so that the seam is in the centre and stitch across one short end. Trim corners turn through the open end and press.
- Attach the closed end of the hanger behind each bow.
- Position bows evenly along the top of the wallhanging with raw edges even. Pin the bows out of the way of the outside edge seam allowance.
- Layer wadding, backing fabric right side up and wallhanging front right side down. Pin outside edges.

- Use a walking foot to stitch around outside edges leaving a 3” opening on one side and stitching around your scallop markings.
- Clip curves, trim corners and turn through. Slip stitch opening closed and press well.
- Quilt if desired or necessary.
